

Ballet 4 2024-2025 Class Information

Class Description:

This is an intermediate-advanced course in classical ballet technique. Students in this level will add greater complexity to their dancing and artistry while continuing to build their technique in the study of barre, centre, allegro, and pointe work. Students in this level may take UNLIMITED technique classes in any level below their own. Pointe work is incorporated into each class; however, there is a dedicated pointe class on Saturdays as well.

Once a week, students study Variations, a course in classical ballet repertoire. Individual students may be asked to perform these variations in the Student Showcase on April 26.

Dress Code:

Boys: white T-shirt, black leggings, white tights, black ballet shoes.

Girls: black leotard, any style except halters, rhinestones, and cut-outs; pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in a neat and secure bun. No jewelry or warm-ups allowed unless approved by instructor. A matching skirt may be worn during Variations and on observation days.

Performance:

This class will perform in our annual Summer Concert on June 14, 2025. During the two weeks leading up to the concert, regular classes will be suspended and we will follow a rehearsal schedule that will be sent out by spring break. All rehearsals will take place at the studio except for a tech and/or dress rehearsal at the theater. You may opt out of the performance if you choose.
