

Ballet 2 2024-2025 Class Information

Class Description:

This is a high beginner level course in formal ballet technique. Students begin to study more complex forms of foundational ballet steps at barre and center and add short petit allegro combinations to their jumps. Ports de bras is more integrated into combinations. Students in this level may also, with director approval, take an additional class to prepare for the transition to pointe work.

Schedule:

Mondays, 6:30-7:45 Conditioning and Technique Tuesdays, 6:15-7:30 Pre-Pointe* Wednesdays, 5:45-7:00 Conditioning and Technique *director approval required

Tuition (due the 1st of the month, September-June)

Boys: Free

Girls: \$139/month; additional \$40/month (after discount) for pre-pointe

Additional Fees*:

\$25 registration fee (per family) \$60 costume fee (due December 1) \$50 performance fee (due March 1) *fees are non-refundable

Dress Code:

Boys: white fitted T-shirt, black tights, white socks, black ballet shoes (canvas preferred).

<u>Girls</u>: plum leotard, tank style only. Pink tights, pink ballet shoes (canvas preferred). On parent observation days, girls may wear a matching skirt with their uniform.

Hair must be neatly secured in a bun. No jewelry, false nails, or warm-ups unless approved by the instructor. Skirts may only be worn on observation or costume days.

Performance:

This class will perform in our annual Summer Concert on June 14, 2025. During the two weeks leading up to the concert, regular classes will be suspended and we will follow a rehearsal schedule that will be sent out by spring break. All rehearsals will take place at the studio except for a tech and/or dress rehearsal at the theater. You may opt out of the performance if you choose.
